



What is Kickstart?


The Kickstart Scheme is a £2 billion fund to create 6-month job placements for young people aged 16-24 currently on Universal Credit and at risk of long-term unemployment. It's part of the government's 'Plan for Jobs' and is funded by the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP). The first placements are available from November 2020 and will continue through to December 2021.


Funding for the employer will cover, for each job placement:

- 100% of the relevant National Minimum Wage for 25 hours per week
- The associated employer National Insurance Contributions
- Employer minimum Automatic Enrolment Contributions*

The Scheme asks that the young people are provided with the 'wrap-around support' to build on their experience and help them move into sustained employment after they have completed their Kickstart Scheme funded job placement.
